Registration Transfer Deadline

The Transfer Deadline this year is **Friday 26th February 2010**.

Therefore, to ensure that a player can be Effectively Registered by this date all the required paperwork must be received **by Friday 19th February for standard 7-day registrations**, or where expedited registration is required, **by 3pm on Thursday 25th February**.

No player may be Effectively Registered after 26th February 2010 to play in any RFU competition this season, unless he falls within the exception set out in Regulation 2.1 of the RFU Registration of Adult Players regulations:

- a Permitted Player or
- he has achieved his seventeenth birthday after the Transfer Deadline and is thereby entitled to Effective Registration for the first time or
- he is an England Academy Player seeking Effective Registration with the Club of whose academy he is a member or
- he is an England Academy Player playing under licence in the Guinness Premiership in accordance with the regulations applicable to that competition
- he is a Loan Player seeking Effective Registration with the Club which loaned him and with which he still has a contract (“the loaning club”), the Club to which he was loaned being at least one level below the loaning club

You must ensure that all registration papers (for example, but not limited to; fully completed Player Registration form, international clearance, club release, copy of passport and visa etc), are present and correct as any problems with them may result in the player missing the Transfer Deadline.

Phoning in of results

While we are keen that you should phone your result in as soon as possible after the game and before the 5.30 deadline please ensure you know the score before you call. There has been an increasing trend where a club phones backs a second time shortly afterwards with a slight amendment to the score. This causes unnecessary work at an already busy time. Clubs in National 3 SW should also be aware how many tries they and their opponents scored so the correct bonus points can be entered.
